SECOND OFFENSE	- Written up, parent contacted, and sent home remainder of the day. - Suspended for 5-7 Recreation days.
THIRD OFFENSE	- Written up, and removal from the program for the remainder of the season.

- Attendees will not steal from other attendees, staff, or program.
 - Attendees will not fight or intimidate other attendees or staff members.
 - Attendees will not vandalize or cause property damage.
 - Attendees will not smoke or drink on the grounds.

FIRST OFFENSE	- Written up, suspended for 7 Recreation days, parent is phoned, and attendee is sent home immediately.
SECOND OFFENSE	- Written up, and removal from the program for the remainder of the season.

PLEASE NOTE: 3 Write-ups a season will result in a suspension of that child for the remainder of the current season.
