RESOLUTION: APPROVE REMOVAL OF TREE AT WATER DISTRICT #1 PUMP HOUSE

WHEREAS, a deteriorating Sycamore tree, located adjacent to the Collins Water District #1 Pump House, poses a threat to the Pump House and fencing should it fall.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Collins Town Board hereby authorizes Natures Pride to cut and remove the tree, grind the stump, clean up the grindings, add top soil and seed per their quote of \$3,000.00 dated 3/20/23.

RESOLUTION: APPROVE PURCHASE OF RADIO COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT FOR THE TOWN HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Collins Highway Department wishes to update its Radio Communication System, as the present system does not provide clear communication to all areas of the town, and

WHEREAS, the Collins Highway Department sent out Request for Proposals (RFPs) to SAIA Communications, Inc, to Telecom Communications, Inc and to Finger Lakes Communications Company, Inc, receiving only one proposal, that of SAIA Communications, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Collins Town Board hereby accepts the proposal of SAIA Communications, Inc, 100 Stradtman Street, Buffalo, NY 14206, to provide eleven (11) mobile, two (2) portable and one (1) base station two-way radios, with installation, one year's cost of SAIANET

CONNECTPLUS SYSTEM fees and trade-in values of old radios for a total cost of \$15,593.33, and that the Funds to purchase the equipment be taken from the 2023 Town Budget Line DB 5130.200 Machinery – Equipment.

RESOLUTION: APPROVE ADJUSTMENT TO CUSTOMER WATER BILL

WHEREAS, Water District #3 Account #51410000 customer Robert Aderman's 2023 First Quarter water bill is \$644.14, which is several times higher than his average bill of approximately of \$160.00, and

WHEREAS, the Water Department personnel determined that he had a water leak, which was found to be in the barn which was not presently housing any animals, and

WHEREAS, the Town's past practice is to forgive one-half of the difference between the average water bill and the water bill after a significant water leak.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Collins Town Board approves that Robert Aderman's 2023 First Quarter water bill be adjusted to be \$402.07, determined as follows:

Current bill of \$644.14 minus average bill of \$160.00 = \$484.14 water leak

One-half of \$484.14 = \$242.07 customer share

Customer average of \$160.00 plus \$242.07 = \$402.07 adjusted bill

RESOLUTION: GRANT USDA PROPERTY ACCESS REQUEST

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has requested permission from the Town of Collins to place traps on Town owned properties for the purpose of monitoring the spread of the European Cherry Fruit Fly (ECFF) and the Box Tree Moth (BTM) across NYS.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Collins Town Board hereby grants permission to the USDA to place traps on Town Properties for the purpose of monitoring the spread of the ECFF and the BTM.
