WHEREAS, Matt Kolo Excavating LLC, contractor for the Town's Drainage Improvements Project, has requested a Change Order that increases the contract price by \$1,624.95 for work associated with connecting the old 12-inch storm line to the new 12-inch storm line along the west side of Mill Street between 14069 and 14068 Mill Street to address a notable wet area present after the storm system was active. WHEREAS, on November 13, 2023 the Collins Town Board adopted a twelve (12) months moratorium on utilities scale Solar, Wind Turbine and Battery Energy Storage Projects in the Town of Collins, and

WHEREAS, on December 9, 2024 the Collins Town Board extended that moratorium by six (6) months to run until May 31, 2025, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to extend the moratorium for six (6) additional months in order to finalize new Town codes that address the siting of the utilities scale Solar, Wind Turbine and Battery Energy Storage Projects in the Town of Collins.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Collins Town Board hereby approves a six (6) month extension, to run from June 1, 2025 through November 30, 2025, of the moratorium on the issuance of applications and granting of permits for siting of commercial Solar Panel, Wind Turbine and Battery Power Projects in the Town of Collins.
