Presentation of the 2023 Tentative Budget by the Town Clerk.

Supervisor Martin handed out and went through a packet outlining the proposed changes to the 2023 Budget.

Discussion held on the recreation program. Recreation Director Samantha McMullen handed out a packet outlining new pricing for the attendees. Mrs. McMullen stated she would need a minimum of ten staff to run the winter program. We did not receive enough attendant applications for the program. In view of this. It looks like we will not have a winter program this year.

New Topics

1. Chimney repair – while taking the chimney down they found cracks in the stucco. They will come up with a price to do the repairs. They also found water damage in the roof. A contractor looked at it and will get back with a price to repair the roof, fascia and gutters. (This is two difference projects with two different contractors.)

2. Solar Law for solar farms - a basic law that would beef up the law we now have, including battery storage and the master plan would have to be addressed. Erie County has grant money we can put in for and use some of our own money.
