### RESOLUTION: AUTHORIZE REPLACE OF CONCRETE PAD AT THE TOWN LIBRARY REAR SERVICE ENTRANCE

WHEREAS, the concrete pad at the rear service entrance to the library slopes slightly towards the entrance door, and

WHEREAS, water that pools there is rusting out the metal door and doorframe, and

WHEREAS, a quote to replace the concrete pad was obtained.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Collins Town Board hereby accepts the quote of Valone Concrete in the amount of \$750.00 to remove and replace a 8' x 9' concrete pad at the library rear service entrance door.
