NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Collins Town Board hereby approves entering into the Intermunicipal Agreement with Erie County whereby the Town will receive \$16,000 in grant funds to be used for an update to the Town's Comprehensive Plan and Solar Law and to develop a Battery Energy Storage System Law for the Town; and that the Town Supervisor be authorized to sign such Intermunicipal Agreement.
