- 4. Superintendent of Highways \$61,836.88 base amount, and an additional \$2,000.00 to supervise the Parks and Transfer Station, making the total \$63,836.88 per annum

Dated: October 18, 2021 By Order of the Town Board BECKY JO SUMMERS, Town Clerk Supervisor Martin presented an overview of the budget explaining line items have been fairly consistent for many years and the minimum wage is increasing so wages will increase. Also gone over were handouts of taxable values, sales tax revenues, 2022 capital projects, tax cap form, yearly comparison sheet and tax rates from 2010 to 2022.
