RESOLUTION: SUPPORT NEW YORK & LAKE ERIE RAILROAD GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Collins Town Board supports the New York and Lake Erie Railroad's (NY&LE) grant application through the Passenger & Freight Rail Assistance Program (PFRAP) for the rehabilitation of approximately five miles of track between Cherry Creek and Conewango Valley, which is part of the Buffalo to Jamestown Rail Corridor and the Western New York Rail Initiative (WNYRI), that we believe is an integral part of the on-going efforts to promote tourism activity and maintain the line for future economic development along the corridor, and

WHEREAS, the NY&LE currently operates in the Village of Gowanda and the Town of Persia, and

WHEREAS, the grant would allow the track to be upgraded to Class II and allow NY&LE to resume tourist passenger excursions from Gowanda to South Dayton, Cherry Creek and Conewango Valley, bringing tourist dollars to the communities and lay the groundwork for future passenger trains to operate between Buffalo and Jamestown, and

WHEREAS, the economic stimulus created by tourist trains operating along the corridor will ensure its long-term viability for use by potential future freight rail shippers.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Collins Town Board supports the NY&LE plan to resume tourist rail excursions between Gowanda and Conewango Valley as a vehicle to keep the larger Buffalo to Jamestown rail corridor viable for future passenger excursions and development projects along the route, and supports the NY&LE grant application through PFRAP, and

WHEREAS, the Town Highway Superintendents Association of Erie County, Inc. negotiated a new agreement for the period of September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2019, setting the reimbursement rates as follows:

2016-17 Snow Season \$3,818.99 per lane mile, 2017-18 Snow Season 3% increase, 2018-19 Snow Season 3% increase, and

WHEREAS, the agreement includes all activities necessary to control snow and ice, together with all necessary labor, equipment, and materials.
